From the Pastor's Desk

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:13)

I write this article during Holy Week, anticipating the two worship services on Easter morning when we will have the largest number of people in the sanctuary in more than a year. I find those words hard to comprehend! This has been such a long, uncertain journey. If you are like me, you must be weary of waiting and hoping for a return to some semblance of community life like it used to be.

Looking ahead, with great anticipation, your Session is making plans for church life as we return to in-person activities. You are already familiar with some of these plans. The replacing of our old hymnals with the new Presbyterian Hymnal anticipates the return to in-person worship without restrictions on hymn singing. I look forward to hearing enthusiastic, congregational singing!

Over the last year, we have had a single, 10:00 a.m. worship service, which is live-streamed, recorded, and posted online. Many of you have enjoyed the opportunity to worship *virtually* either at 10:00 a.m. or at another time. As we begin returning to full in-person worship, we will continue to live-stream our worship services. This has been a blessing for those that may be homebound for health reasons and for members and friends that attend Sunrise seasonally.

The question has been asked about adding additional worship services. The answer is yes. The only question is timing. For the next few months, it appears that staying with a single, 10:00 a.m. service is appropriate. Over the summer, we will be planning for what should be an exciting "reopening" in the fall.

Again, this year, we are planning on having a *Virtual* VBS. Last year was a great success, and while everyone is weary of using Zoom, the learning and sharing that happened was absolutely wonderful!

Easter 2021

There is no Community Sunrise Service again this year (Sullivan's Island's mask and distancing mandates make this gathering impractical). Once again, I will live-stream sunrise over Breach Inlet on Easter morning, playing Heidi and Kent Kenyon's rendition of *Jesus Christ Has Risen Today* and reading the Gospel of John's account of Mary Magdalene's encounter with the Risen Lord. Sunrise on Easter morning is at 6:29 a.m.

There are two Easter Morning Worship Services in the sanctuary at 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Because of limited seating, reservations are necessary. Sign-ups have gone well and the 11:00 a.m. service has reached its seating limit. There are still some seats available at the 9:00 a.m. service. A note about seating, there are some family reservations that will fill a couple of pews. The seating limit is not simply about open pews, it is about the total number of people in the sanctuary. It looks as if the weather is going to be mild on Easter, so we can open outside doors for better air circulation. Both worship services will be live-streamed, recorded, and posted online.

I am thrilled that we can gather this year in our sanctuary for The Celebration of the Resurrection!


In God's grace,


