On the last Sunday in May, Trinity Sunday, I preached a sermon on *The Power of Presence*. The scripture lesson from Exodus recounted Moses meeting with God in the tent of meeting. Whenever Moses met with God, the pillar of cloud would appear at the entrance of the tent. The people of Israel could see that God was present.

On Trinity Sunday, we celebrate how God is present in the life of the church. Jesus promised the disciples that he was sending the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, to *teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you*. (John 14:26) The gift of the Holy Spirit energized and inspired the church, sending the disciples out into the world with confidence.

You may not know how difficult clergy find preaching about the Trinity. Sermons on the Trinity run the risk of being theoretical and rather abstract. Describing God as the *Three-in-One* can easily plunge us into a theological discourse. This Trinity Sunday, I tried to focus on two aspects about God that the Trinity reveals: *the power of God's presence* and *relationships*.

The scripture passage from Exodus shows us how God was actively present with the people of Israel. The pillar of cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night were visual reminders that God was present. The church has affirmed the reality that Jesus, as the Son of God, was fully human and fully divine. As the Apostle Paul would later write in II Corinthians, ⁶For it is the God who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. (II Cor. 4:6) The Apostles experienced God as the Creator, the Redeemer, and the Sustainer. This was not a theoretical idea that struck them; it was an encounter with the living God as the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

As we emerge from the physical distancing of the pandemic, being physically present with each other and nurturing our relationships with our brothers and sisters in Christ is a testimony to God's continual presence in our lives and the bonds of love that we witness in God's very being as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

I invite you to notice the many ways *In-Pe*rson activities are returning to Sunrise. The *Women's Evening Bible Study* with Reece is being held both on Zoom and in-person. In June, the *Adult Bible Study Class* will begin meeting at 11:15 a.m., immediately after the 10:00 a.m. Worship Service. It will be both in-person and on Zoom. The *Men's Prayer Breakfast* will resume gather on the second Tuesday in June (June 8) at 7:30 a.m. ~ as we are saying, *New Start, New Day, New Time!*

As we move through the summer, we are making plans for a much-anticipated fall with a return to familiar in-person activities!


