### From the Pastor's Desk

### The Grand Reopening

As in-person activities have increased around Sunrise, lots of people have been asking about the plans for resuming our pre-pandemic Sunday morning schedule. Your Session has discussed the resumption and its timetable.

#### Grand Reopening Scheduled for Sunday, September 12th

#### Why the delay?

There are two reasons: 1) summer vacation travel, and 2) weekend beach traffic.

After a year-and-a-half of restricted travel, people are taking summer vacations. It is estimated that 71% of Americans have plans to travel this summer! In addition, the Charleston County Schools did not let out for summer vacation until June 18. So the travel schedule is compressed into fewer weeks this summer. Lots of people are out of town in July and early August.

Weekend beach traffic is always a challenge. Some of you remember when Sunrise Presbyterian would change the hour of its then single worship service during the summer. It would change from 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. during the summer to avoid beach traffic. Since so many people have plans to be out of town this summer, it seemed prudent to continue with our single 10:00 a.m. worship service through July and August.

#### New Sunday Morning Schedule

Well, not that much; but, there is a bit of a change.

One of the parts of in-person church life that has been completely put on hold is *Fellowship*. The last Sunday morning fellowship at Sunrise was March 8, 2020! To say it is desperately missed would be an understatement. Looking towards resuming our *Fellowship Life*, I began asking how we might further emphasize it. Instead of hosting two fellowships, one after the *Early Service* and the other after the 11:00 a.m. Worship Service, we are going to try something new. We are going to *anchor* Sunday mornings with an extended fellowship. The idea is to make it a *crossroads* for all of our Sunday morning services.

Fellowship will begin at 9:30 a.m. and continue until 10:45 a.m. Tables will be setup for those who would like to sit and chat. Food will include a continental breakfast, and on occasion a brunch menu. People have the options of coming from the *Early Service*, arriving before Sunday School, coming down to fellowship after the *Family Service*, and arriving before the 11:00 a.m. Worship Service. There will still be coffee available after the 11:00 a.m. service.

On September 12, the first Sunday after the Labor Day Weekend, the Sunday morning schedule will look likes this:

9:00 a.m.	<i>Early Service</i> (in the sanctuary)
9:30 a.m.	Fellowship begins (in the Fellowship Hall)
10:00 a.m.	Family Service (in the Family Chapel) and Adult Sunday School (in the Library)
10:20 a.m.	Sunday School for Children (2 <sup>nd</sup> floor of the Education Wing)
10:45 a.m.	Fellowship finishes
11:00 a.m.	Worship Service (in the sanctuary)
12:00 p.m.	Coffee (in the Fellowship Hall)

We are going to give this revised schedule a try to see how it might help us to get to know people that are attending other worship services. This is very much *a work in progress*.

Live-streaming our worship services will continue. The New Dawn Worship Service is being discussed, but will remain on pause for the moment.

September promises to be an incredibly special time this year. Please mark your calendar and plan to meet your friends, *in-person*, at Sunrise!

#### Stephen Ministers are there:

- ... *after* the phone call you hoped you'd never get.
- ... *after* the funeral, when everyone has left and the emotions you've held at bay come crashing in on you.
- ... after the relationship falls apart and the bottom falls out of your life.
- . . after the doctor says, "I'm sorry, but there's nothing more we can do."
- . . *after* the nursing home director shakes your hand and says, "Welcome to your new home."
- ... *after* the last child honks the horn, waves, and drives away—and the house suddenly seems empty.
  - ... *after* the gavel comes down, the handcuffs go on, and your loved one is led away.
    - ... *after* the baby arrives, demanding more of you than you ever dreamed possible.

. . *after* you find a pink slip with your final paycheck.

...*after* your family and friends have heard your story one too many times, but you still need to talk it out.

Stephen Ministers are the After People. They are ready to come alongside you—or your friends, neighbors, coworkers, or relatives—and provide comfort and support for as long *after* as needed.


