

Welcome

Recently, I read an observation made by another pastor about visitors to worship. We all know how important it is to greet visitors and make them feel welcome. The pastor noted a concern that is related to how we make visitors feel like *welcomed guests*.

This pastor noticed that most first-time *guests* arrive ten minutes before the worship service begins. In the case of the worship service he was referencing, there is an extended time of congregational singing at the beginning of the service. Frequently, people are arriving ten minutes into the worship hour. Watching the first-time guests, he noticed them sitting alone for sometimes 15-20 minutes.

At Sunrise, I frequently tell first-time guests that we are a congregation that lives on *island time*, arriving right on the hour. Most first-time guests arrive ten minutes before worship is scheduled to begin. It is not unusual, especially at the 9:00 a.m. Service, for them to be the first worshippers in the sanctuary.

This observation is not intended to chastise anyone, but I believe it reveals something that is incredibly important for all of us to recognize. Greeting first-time guests is part of our outreach ministry. The saying is true: people make their decision about a church in the first ten minutes. Being greeted in the sanctuary by fellow worshippers creates a truly welcoming experience.

I plan to change my routine for the 9:00 a.m. Service. I will have everything set and ready that I need to do by 8:45 a.m. That way, my schedule is free to meet and greet people as they arrive, first-time guests as well as regular attending worshippers. Would you consider joining me in this new commitment?

On the cover of this month's *Beacon*, is the flooring replacement project. Long delayed, it is extremely timely from a safety standpoint, but also ties in with the observation above. Like many of our homes, we learn to live with and stop noticing aging floorings, paint, etc. It has been brought to our attention from several sources that our beautiful building is showing its cosmetic age.

As you will see, there are five areas designated for flooring replacement, the Fellowship Hall, the kitchen, and the three downstairs restrooms. The cost of each is listed. This project has been jumpstarted by the generosity of several people before it was presented to the congregation on July 24. As of Monday, August 1st we are 84% of the way to the total cost.

Thank you to everyone participating in this very needed work.

A special **thank** you to everyone who came out to distribute school supplies to children in need with Hands of Christ! 86 children were blessed with the supplies they need to for school starting this August!










What's Happening in August at Sunrise
