Stewardship Sunday October 30, 2022 Blest be the tie that binds our hearts in Christian love; the fellowship of kindred minds is like to that above.

This familiar hymn captures the essence of congregational fellowship. On the last Sunday in September, we celebrated as a church family with a single worship service at 10:00 a.m., followed by a cookout/cover dish at 11:00 a.m. The Fellowship Hall came alive with conversation and laughter! While it had been a couple of years since we had a cover dish meal, the outpouring of people's favorite dishes was amazing! The dessert tables were incredible! The fellowship around the tables was so heartwarming to see and experience!

Worship was special! We used parts of the Family Service, and our children and young people chimed in with energy and enthusiasm! The service closed with singing their favorite song, "This Little Light of Mine!" Matthew and the choir led the singing, and our young people came to the front of the Sanctuary to do their traditional dancing to this wonderful song!

We come to church to be fed, body and soul. Worship renews our spirits as together we pray, sing, and embrace God's calling for our lives. There is a deep connection between the Sanctuary and the Fellowship Hall. As simple as it sounds, gathering in the Fellowship Hall and sharing food is an essential part of our faith! In *breaking bread* together, we nurture the deep roots of our care and compassion for one another.

The energy and enthusiasm of having so many people back in church has led people to ask what we can do to experience more of this joy and energy. We will definitely have more Sundays with a single 10:00 a.m. worship service and a cover dish lunch following. We are planning to do this at least quarterly. The Session discussed at its September meeting if changes to our Sunday morning schedule might bring more people together. The Elders will be asking you for your input and ideas.

The theme of this year's Stewardship Season is *Time, Talents,* and *Treasure*. Too often, we think of stewardship in strictly financial terms, that is, what money we donate to the church; however, stewardship involves so much more than our financial commitment. God has entrusted to us our time and talents, as well as financial resources. We are encouraged to share all three in service to the ministry and mission of Sunrise. During the month of October, we will be offering brief reflections from church members about how they apply these three aspects of their commitment to the church.

The *In-Person* life and activities of Sunrise are definitely returning with energy and enthusiasm. The Men's Prayer Breakfast meets each Tuesday morning at 7:30 a.m. Adult Sunday school is held in the church library. Both the Miriam-Naomi Circle and the Women's Evening Bible Study meet in-person. Youth Group has weekly meetings in the Fellowship Hall. Our annual *Live Nativity* with its traditional animals was a success last year and is scheduled for Saturday, December 10th this year. Our two Christmas Eve Services returned to the Sanctuary last year.

As we plan for the Christmas Season, may we catch the joyful spirit of the season and the many opportunities for us to be together!


