

From the Pastor's Desk

It's September!

This month's *Beacon* is filled with activities! There is literally something for everyone! Let me suggest you consider choosing a new activity in the life of Sunrise. These opportunities fall into a number of categories designed to meet a variety of interests and needs.

Worship

There are three weekly worship services: 9:00 a.m. Devotional Service, 10:00 a.m. Family Service, and the 11:00 a.m. Worship Service. Each is designed to meet different worship needs. While the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. share the same scripture and message, the musical offerings are different. At 11:00 a.m. the choir provides inspiring anthems, duets, and solos. The 10:00 a.m. Family Service is held in the Family Chapel upstairs in the Education Wing. It is designed to introduce children to worship. The older children are invited to help in leading parts of the service.

Education

There are a number of educational opportunities at Sunrise from weekly to monthly.

Weekly: Each Sunday morning, during the 10:00 a.m. hour there is an Adult Sunday school class that meets in the church library that I teach. Following the Family Service, there is a Sunday school class for the children. It includes a craft that emphasizes that week's scripture. Each Tuesday morning, the Men's Prayer Breakfast meets at 7:30 a.m. for a wonderful breakfast, followed by a devotional based on a scripture passage.

Monthly: Once a month, there is a Morning and Evening Bible study for women. The morning Bible study is the Miriam-Naomi Circle that meets on the second Tuesday of each month at 10:00 a.m. On the third Tuesday evening of the month, Reece leads the Women's Evening Bible Study. Please read the articles about each of these groups. New this fall is a monthly Sunday school class for 4th through 8th graders. It will meet at 9:00 a.m. on the third Sunday of the month.

Youth: Youth Group is resuming on September 11th. This fall there will be the weekly gatherings on Sunday evening and a once a month event. If you are not on the contact list for Youth Group, you may send your contact information to the church office at: sunrisepresbyterian3222@gmail.com.

Fellowship

Weekly: Each Sunday we have fellowship beginning at 9:30 a.m. and continuing until after the 11:00 a.m. Worship Service. It is a wonderful way to meet new friends and keep up with each other's lives.

Monthly: The FEAST groups meet monthly. They build a strong, supportive bond between Sunrise members. Please check out the insert about FEAST in this month's *Beacon*. The weekly Men's Prayer Breakfast is a fellowship group, as is the monthly Miriam-Naomi Circle.

Special Events: On Sunday, September 25th we will have a special church-wide worship/fellowship day! There will be a single 10:00 a.m. worship service followed by a cookout and covered dish lunch. A jump castle for the children will be set up outside the Fellowship Hall.


