#### A Special Easter Season

#### Holy Week

Mark your calendar! This year, Holy Week closes out the month of March. It is a full week of special events. We will celebrate Maundy Thursday with the Passover Seder/Last Supper in the Fellowship Hall and Good Friday with *The Service of Shadows* beginning at 7:30 p.m. Easter morning begins with the Community Sunrise Service on the beach at Breach Inlet. This year, it starts at 7:00 a.m. with the sun rising over the ocean at 7:08 a.m. Let me describe each of these special events and encourage you to attend.

### Palm Sunday, March 24th

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday. It is a wonderful celebration. We will be combining The Family Service and 10:00 a.m. Worship Service for the joyful celebration! Our annual Easter Egg Hunt will be held in the Fellowship Hall at 10:30 a.m. Children are invited to bring their baskets!

## Maundy Thursday, March 28th at 6:00 p.m.

This year, we will be in the Fellowship Hall sharing the Passover Seder meal and the Lord's Supper. This is a very special evening. The Last Supper that Jesus celebrated with his disciples in the Upper Room was the Passover Seder. It retells the story of God rescuing the people of Israel from Egypt. It was during the Last Supper that Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper. This event makes that important connection as we first share the celebration of the Passover and then finish the evening with Communion.

## Good Friday Service of Shadows, March 29th at 7:30 p.m.

Good Friday sets the stage for the glory of Easter morning! During *The Service of Shadows* we are brought to the foot of the Cross. As the sun sets the sanctuary is filled with shadows until it is nearly dark. The service closes with the tolling of a bell thirty-three times for each year of our Lord's earthly life. If you have never attended *The Service of Shadows*, I invite you to experience the journey of Jesus from the Upper Room to the Garden of Gethsemane to his final words on the Cross.

### Easter Sunday, March 31st

#### Community Sunrise Service on the Beach, March 31st at 7:00 a.m.

Easter morning dawns with the Community Sunrise Service on the beach at Breach Inlet. This is an ecumenical, community worship service with many of the churches on the islands participating. The service begins at 7:00 a.m. [sunrise is at 7:08 a.m.]

## Celebration of the Resurrection, March $31^{st} \sim 10:00$ a.m.

This Easter, the Session voted to have a single 10:00 a.m. worship service in the sanctuary. We will have the *Flowering of the Cross* and Reece Humphreys is planning a special message for the children before they leave the sanctuary for an Easter craft.

Jesus' journey to Jerusalem and the events of Holy Week highlight the full range of human emotions. Please plan to experience this remarkable week in our savior's life.

A decision is expected to be made very soon. The names of the columbarium company and the landscape/construction company will be communicated as soon as the decisions are final.

Meanwhile, the Legal Committee has been developing a contract for the sale of niches and the rules and regulations. The Finance Committee has been evaluating insurance requirements, and the Niche Sales and Donations Committee has been developing informational material.

The goal is to have the columbarium and garden completed in 2024. We look forward to sharing updates about the project.


This award put Sunrise Presbyterian Church in a very positive light for the Scouting program being presented at our church.
